For this reason, and many others, we're continuing the critical and urgent work of reuniting even more children from other orphanages with their families. We have recently started the reunification process for 63 kids who are and have been living in orphanages for the majority of their young lives. These orphanages requested the support of Overture for reunification efforts because they now believe children SHOULD be with their Family First! That's our desire for every child, and thanks to the faithful support of our generous donors, we have developed a proven approach that successfully reunites families and equips them for long-term success. This approach, known as our Social Support Model, puts family at the forefront of all we do and offers real hope for families and their communities — building Haiti Stronger. That's why, during this season of giving, we're inviting you to join us in putting Family First by helping us to reunify or prevent the separation of 100 families by year-end.

Family First Succeeds — Bethsaida Blossoms

Bethsaida is a 12-year-old girl living with her family of seven in a community near Les Cayes. When Bethsaida was a small child, her mother relinquished her to the ESPWA orphanage because she could not provide for Bethsaida's educational or daily needs. After many years of separation, Bethsaida was reunited with her family when Overture undertook the reunification process of 252 ESPWA orphanage children in 2019. After her reunification, and with the support of Overture donors, Bethsaida started school and her mother began participating in child protection training and vocational skills training. The family also worked alongside their community to build a brand new house that they now



share with another family. And they are currently partnering with Overture to improve their financial situation. This family is well on its way to self-reliance and, most importantly, they are together and moving toward a more independent life. Bethsaida's mother shares,

"The fact that we are together makes us stronger. I'm able to support Bethsaida and my other children in their education, and I have hope that I will be able to fully provide for them very soon. Without Overture, none of this would be possible."
