As we look back on 2025, we do so with profound gratitude for you and the role you played in a year defined by both extraordinary challenges, natural disasters and remarkable progress. Your generosity enabled us, alongside our Haitian partners, to respond with both compassion in moments of crisis and sustainable, Haitian-led solutions that protect children, strengthen families and build pathways toward long-term independence. Your partnership made it possible for hope to take root and it encouraged us to **endure even in the hardest moments**.

This annual report celebrates that endurance. It is a testament to what happens when we refuse to lose hope.

- Through **Advocacy and Family Preservation**, we launched the third and final installment of *Orphanages Are NOT the Answer*, a critical resource that equips donors and partners with a deeper understanding of why family-based care is essential for children to thrive.
- When flooding threatened livelihoods and homes, your support allowed our teams to respond immediately, **helping families remain together** rather than face permanent displacement or separation.
- In partnership with IBESR (Haiti's Child Welfare Agency), we continued the transformation of the former ESPWA orphanage campus by turning it into Haiti's first **Community Complex for Child Protection**, a Haitian-led model that is now strengthening the national child welfare system from within.

These are not just updates; they are evidence of God at work in the midst of hardship.

As we close this year of incredible endurance, we look ahead to 2026 with even more hope and determination.
